**Community Watershed Stewardship
Program Grant \$\$ available**

Do you have a great idea for making your neighborhood/school/green space better? The city of Portland will be offering grant money for watershed projects.

They offer two types of funding for community watershed projects.

Native Plant Mini Grants of up to \$300 for projects that improve watershed health. Mini grant applications are reviewed throughout the year -- there is no deadline. They are available to both community groups and some private landowners.

Community Watershed Stewardship Grants provide up to \$10,000 to schools, churches, businesses and other community organizations for projects that connect people with watersheds and protect and enhance watershed health. These annual grants are funded through a competitive process based on the merits of the project and CWSP goals for watershed and community benefit.

The central city grant writing workshop is scheduled for 10:30 AM Saturday, January 22nd at the Central Library; 801 SW 10th Ave. An additional workshop will be announced for East Portland.

The North Portland grant writing workshop will be at 6:00 PM, Wednesday January 26th at Kenton Library: 8226 N Denver Ave.
