

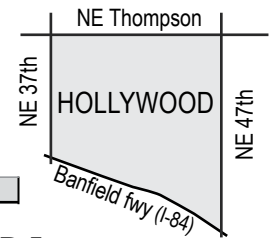

### Hollywood Farmers Market

The Hollywood Farmers Market will begin the 2007 season on the first Saturday in May (May 5). Located on NE Hancock between 44th and 45th Avenues in the Hollywood District. Hours are 8 AM to 1 PM from May through October - and also extended into the first three weeks of November this year, though starting an hour later (November 3, 10 & 17 from 9 AM to 1 PM).

### Broadway is 2-way Now

The stretch of NE Broadway between 37th and 39th has been made two-way. That's right, if you're coming into the Hollywood from Broadway you no longer are forced to turn right at 37th and go up to Sandy. You can still turn right at 37th or you can continue on Broadway up to 39th where you are directed to turn left toward Tillamook.

### Palm Trees on Sandy

New palm trees have been planted along Sandy Blvd. next to the Hollywood Theatre. The old trees were removed and the sidewalk was rebuilt.

**Did you know? No park in the Hollywood?!**

One of the few neighborhoods in Portland without a park, Hollywood residents and visitors have to make their way over to Grant Park or further to enjoy some outdoor green space. The time is now to start making a Hollywood Urban Park a reality!

- New development is happening, there's an existing and future anticipated deficiency in park space in Hollywood, and there is a need for a permanent home for the farmers market.
- If the Hollywood area community can organize and advocate the city effectively for a Hollywood Urban Park; the city might include the cost for land acquisition in a future year parks bond measure (2009?).

**Next steps:** We are looking for volunteer(s) to help lead HNA and other Hollywood area organizations in coming together and working toward this goal.
