

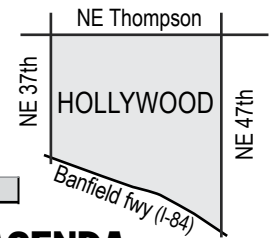

Election of HNA Board & Committee Positions

The Hollywood Neighborhood Association (HNA) Board has some odd-year positions open for re-election.

Eligibility: You should be over 18 years of age and be a resident, property owner, business licensee, or one representative of a governmental agency, or non-profit organization located within the boundaries of HNA (see map upper right). Positions are 2-year terms, unless specified otherwise.

First Alternate (Chairperson) - The First Alternate shall assist the Chairperson; in the Chairperson's absence shall function as Chairperson; shall serve as a member of the Publicity Committee.

Secretary - The Secretary shall keep minutes and written records of majority and minority opinions expressed at all meetings; shall be responsible for all correspondence of HNA; shall make records of HNA available for inspection for any proper purpose at a reasonable time and place.

Finance Committee - The Finance Committee shall secure financial support for the HNA, if necessary, as requested by the Board.

Grievance Committee* - The Grievance Committee shall consist of not less than three members elected by the general membership at the General meeting. *(elected each year)

Big Box Development Proposal at 82nd Withdrawn

(As reported in the CNN coalition Oct 2007 newsletter): SmartCentres has withdrawn their conditional use application for developing the site on NE 82nd. The permit would have expanded the current zoning from 60,000 sq ft to 240,000 sq ft.
