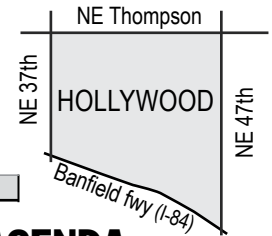

Providence Plans Development in Hollywood District

Providence representative Steve Fletcher will be speaking at the HNA General Meeting to discuss plans for a development in the neighborhood. Providence Medical Center has purchased the Davis Business Center (NE Halsey x 43rd) with plans to develop the property. Issues of concern could be traffic and street parking in an area that has seen a lot of development and increase in traffic in recent years.

The Regional Equity Atlas - A Presentation and Discussion

The Coalition for a Livable Future (CLF) will speak at the HNA General Meeting to discuss the Regional Equity Atlas program. CLF has been researching (partnering with PSU and other groups) equity conditions in the six-county Portland-Vancouver metro area. CLF undertook this work in recognition that while Portland is at the forefront of the sustainability movement, "equity" - the right of every person to access opportunities for meeting basic needs and advancing their health and well-being - has largely been absent from discussions about sustainable development at the metropolitan region level. Hollywood Neighborhood Emergency Team

The Hollywood Neighborhood Emergency Team (NET) is a small group of our neighbors who have volunteered to keep thinking about and being prepared to help the Hollywood Neighborhood area in the event of a large emergency.

NET Volunteers receive 25 hours of training over eight weeks provided by the Fire Bureau at their training center near NE 122nd and Sandy Blvd. This free basic training is three hours a week. Basic training gives you the skills to work with your neighbors to save lives and property during the first 72 hours of any citywide emergency, the period when many neighborhoods will be on their own. These skills will also enable you to manage emergencies you may encounter in daily life. The brief titles of each NET class are: Disaster Preparedness, Fire/HAZMAT/Utilities, Disaster Medicine I, Disaster Medicine II, Search & Rescue I, Search & Rescue II, Disaster Psychology and Team Operations, and Final Exercise. NET Team volunteers receive opportunities for ongoing training and also help distribute emergency

preparedness information like the "Together We Prepare Oregon," (a booklet prepared and printed by the Red Cross) and "High Rise Fire Safety," (a flyer prepared by the Portland Bureau of Fire, Rescue and Emergency Services).
