

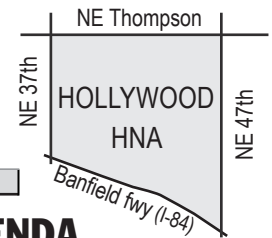

HNA Newsletter Changing to Online Distribution

Starting with the next newsletter in October, the HNA will move to an online-only distribution model. Rising printing costs have made it obvious that we cannot sustain the model of printing and distributing a copy for all residences in the Hollywood.

It is time to take advantage of prevalent technology - free internet availability and free email accounts. There is free wi-fi in neighborhood businesses and free internet access at the Hollywood Library. This will save HNA money, and if we can save some trees in the process, why not?

For the foreseeable future, the HNA will distribute a printed version to several key locations (about 500 copies total):

- Hollywood Library (Tillamook x 41st)
- 42nd St. Station (42nd between Tillamook and Hancock)
- Hollywood Theatre (Sandy x 41st)
- Hollywood East (Broadway x 45th)
- Hollywood Townhouse (4265 NE Halsey)
- CNN (4415 NE 87th Ave.)

Making this change will also allow us to put more focus on the HNA website, with more frequent news and updates. When you visit hollywoodinportland.org you can read or download the newsletter there.
