

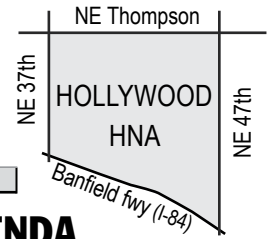


UPCOMING HNA GENERAL MEETING - Open to the public

Bohemian Vintage at 1627 NE 42nd looks to be open any day now selling vintage clothing & accessories. It's the little storefront that was a bicycle accessory store and a chocolate shop before that, behind Blue Fin Sushi.

The NW corner of 42nd & Sandy is looking a little barren lately with the closing of **Bombo**, and before that, the tuxedo shop next door.

Bombo's seemed like a good idea for that spot, but with no seating and no kitchen, it must have faced some hurdles. Maybe this space (which seems too small for running a business) would be more successful if it were combined with the adjacent empty shop?

Hollywood Tattoo is now open for business at 3711 NE Sandy Blvd.

Kelo's, the lottery bar in the Medak building on Sandy near 44th, has closed.

U.S. West Coast Tae Kwon Do has moved a few blocks from Broadway over to Sandy at 42nd in a prominent corner spot with large windows - the old piano store / bank building! Well, at least this corner of 42nd & Sandy is looking lively again.

Also, sadly, **Biscuits Cafe** (on Sandy at 52nd) has closed. Where can you get pancakes or an omelet for breakfast in the Hollywood anymore?
